

Summer 2021 Academics: High School Credit Courses

Each 1-credit class offers the same material as a full-year class, condensed into a 6-week program. Students also get the benefit of smaller class sizes and gain additional skills and experience for help with a college or career choice in the future. Summer courses allow students to satisfy credit requirements in order to free up their schedule during the school year for other courses.

Physical Education [entering 10–12] Online

This distance learning course offers students an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding for their physical and social emotional wellness. Students will engage remotely in meaningful self improvement related to their physical fitness, self awareness and self management. Students will participate in digital class discussions (via Zoom), as well as engaging in activities independently during the three week course. The flexible and individual centered approach offered in this course will provide a positive and meaningful experience for learners. Class Format:

Since the pandemic is a fluid situation the class format will be determined at a later date. The format options may include;

- 1) Online via Distance Learning or Live via Classroom
- 2) Online / In-Person Hybrid
- 3) In-Person at Staples High School

Parents & Students should be aware of the following:

- Staples students seeking to enroll in a for-credit summer course **must obtain prior written approval from:**
- 1) the curriculum coordinator and 2) their school counselor.
- Students outside of Westport Public Schools should obtain the equivalent of the above.
- The hours of class time required for credit will be equivalent to the hours of instruction during the school year.
- Given the pace of the classes, **perfect attendance and punctuality are expected**. If a student misses more than two days of class for any reason, credit will not be granted for the course.
- Courses follow the prescribed Staples High School curriculum and Staples High School assessments.
- Enrollment in follow-up courses at Staples during the school year is contingent upon; successful completion of the summer school course, teacher recommendation, AND seat availability in the desired course, which is not guaranteed.
- If a student misses more than 2 days of class for any reason, credit will not be granted for the course. Students who have lost credit will have the opportunity to appeal to have their credit reinstated. To appeal, please complete the Principal's Hearing Request Form from the Main Office. The deadline for appeals is August 13.
- The deadline to drop a for-credit Westport Continuing Education High School Academics summer course without record and to have the course removed from the student's Staples transcript is the end of the fifth day of the class. If the student withdraws from the course after this date, the student will receive a W (Withdrawn) on their Staples transcript and no credit will be given.
- The deadline to request pass/fail grading in a for-credit Westport Continuing Education High School Academics summer course is the end of the fifth day of the class.
- No refunds will be given for withdrawals from for-credit courses.
